

2013 WAYNESBORO

SHORT FILM COMPETITION

This short film competition created by the Waynesboro Cultural Commission is open to residents of Virginia, West Virginia, Maryland, Kentucky, Tennessee, and North Carolina in **two age categories**: Youth 20 and under and Adults 21+. Your submission should be no longer than 16 minutes in length (including credits). All genres of short film are welcomed. Enter your short film to **win cash prizes** and a chance to have your film screened with other finalists in Waynesboro, Virginia. Final judging will be by Daphne Maxwell Reid who is best known as Aunt Vivian from the hit comedy, "The Fresh Prince of Bel-Air."

Entries with a completed registration form **MUST** be received by the Waynesboro Cultural Commission by **5pm, April 1, 2013** or postmarked by that date. There is a **\$10** Entry Fee. Finalists will be selected from the submissions and screened on Saturday, May 4, 2013 (finalists will be notified of the screening details). Winners in each age category will be announced at the screening. There will also be an audience choice award.

RULES

- The competition is only open to residents of Virginia and the contiguous states of West Virginia, Maryland, Kentucky, Tennessee, North Carolina and students attending schools in those states.
- All entries must be received or postmarked by the Waynesboro Cultural Commission at the address referenced on the registration form by April 1, 2013 accompanied with a completed, signed registration form and the \$10 Entry Fee (**cashier's check or money order from USA banks only**).
- Films submitted without the proper entry fee will not be accepted or considered. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- All entries must be submitted on standard DVD—non-working DVDs will be disqualified.
- All entries must be appropriate for an all-ages audience. No nudity, excessive violence or swearing.
- All entries must be no longer than 16 minutes in length (including credits). DVDs longer than 16 minutes will be disqualified.
- A participant may submit only one film.
- Projects with paid distribution contracts, including DVD and theatrical, are not eligible.
- Participants are responsible for securing rights for the use of all previously copyrighted material used in the entry.
- All entries must be the original work of the entrant.
- All registration forms by entrants under age 18 must also be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- Finalist films and winning films from previous years are ineligible for re-entry in the competition.
